



**Summer Madness 2011 Friday 1st – Tuesday 5th July
Parent / Guardian Application & Consent Form**

To Parent / Guardian,

Ouch! Summer Madness is creeping up, and for those who want to go and save money with an early bird booking (£62 camper fee by Dec 14th), now's your time to act. A separate application form is required for each individual child. For booking please read carefully the below process and criteria for bookings:

Process:

Step 1: go online, book online, and choose if you want to pay online or receive an invoice in the post. When you book, you'll be asked to choose a church from a drop down menu...you choose 'East Belfast Mission'. Please note, payments must be made by individuals either at time of booking or within 7 days of booking online. Web address: <http://register.summermadness.co.uk/>

Step 2: complete and hand in this form to the Youth Department, EBM either at Church or at Stepping Stone and you will receive confirmation EBM are happy to bring you along.

Step 3: nearer the time, we'll be asking for the EBM supervision fee (£10 per child) and providing you with optional food choices for lunch and dinner times.

Notes:

1. All bookings are for secondary school young people up to and including 19yrs. All application forms must be handed / posted in either directly to the Youth Department at EBM, or via Mark McFeeters. Please refrain from handing any other leaders these forms / money, as they have been instructed not to take them ;-)
2. As places are limited due to number of leaders going (and our young-person-to-leader ratios) we will be using the following selection criteria to process applications.
 - a. Those young people who are known to us as regular attendees of one or more of the following: Friday fusion helpers, attendees of Re:act, Football, Dance Nation or EBM congregation. Those involved in EBM schools work may also be eligible to come with EBM.
3. **Only persons booking through EBM may share tents / accommodation.** You must not book through us, and then have others share your tent that have not booked through EBM as this complicates supervision and responsibility rights and duties.

PRICING STRUCTURE:

Your compulsory costs will be the camper's fee, plus the EBM Supervisory fee noted below. Optional costs will be regarding food requirements which will be organised prior to event.

There are three pricing brackets, which depend on the time at which you book...the earlier you book, the better the price, but the quicker the deadline to pay the full amount! Once you miss the cut off date for each deadline below, you automatically go into the next higher price bracket.

SM: 11 Application CONSENT FORM (Terms & Conditions)

(If you are 18+, we still require parental / guardian signature to approve terms and conditions laid out below)

I agree to (name and age of child at time of July 1st) _____ (Date of birth: _____) attending this event under the supervision of EBM. In signing above, I understand and agree with EBM's booking process, costs and criteria, as well as EBM's position concerning:

1. Leaving & entering the camp site: EBM will only allow your child to exit the camp site if you give prior approval that they may do so, for example, if they wish to return home for a shower or to get new clothes etc. The young person's assigned leader must also be informed, and the young person must also have 'signed out' on the 'exit / entrance' sheet that leaders will have. They must inform their leader also once they have re-entered the campsite, and signed back in. We are not supporting or supervising any requests to simply 'go out of the campsite for a walkabout', but within reason, will be happy to facilitate small groups accompanied by a leader to visit the local garage for food supplies / confectionary etc. If however, you wish your child to stay in the campsite at all times, please circle your answer here: **'I am happy for my child to partake in short visits to the garage'? YES / NO**
2. It is compulsory that my child will attend all morning (11:00) and evening (19:30) main stage sessions, though are free to choose which seminar / workshops they wish to attend outside of the main stage sessions. They will inform their assigned EBM leader of their intentions in this regard.
3. My child will abide by the conditions outlined in this consent form, as well as the conditions outlined in the Summer Madness Festival Ground Rules document attached. Please note, the Kings Hall grounds are vast, and so we consider it unrealistic that all our young people will be in constant ear and eye-shot of our leaders. It is critical therefore that young people be responsible for their behaviour, and are committed to keeping in regular contact with their assigned EBM leader, or other EBM leaders when necessary.
4. If my child signs up to meal times with EBM, they will be responsible for their own clearing up, and will support the general clearing up requirements as directed by EBM leaders.
5. I understand that any other visits outside of accompanied visits with leaders to the garage round the corner, (i.e. trips home for a shower), that a leader in charge needs to receive either a text from a parents mobile, or a hand written permission slip specific to the day and time you are happy for your child to leave the premises. Note, it is SM rules that all young people need to be escorted offsite by a recognised group leader, and ideally should be met by a recognised and known parent / guardian.

These policies in respect of supervision, apply to those young people aged 18yrs and under who come under EBM. 18 yr olds attending as part of the youth still require parental consent before being accepted into the group.
